100% RECYCLED

The Fairweather Johnson line is made entirely from recycled materials. Recycled cotton involves converting used cotton fabric into fibers that can be reprocessed into new products, such as those featured in this catalog. Utilizing reclaimed manufacturing techniques can lead to a reduction of 60 gallons of water usage per t-shirt and a 45% decrease in carbon footprint.



THE PROCESS



Textile waste marks the beginning of Fairweather Johnson, not the conclusion. We utilize leftover scraps and fabric from production, known as post-industrial waste, and combine them with post-consumer waste, such as worn clothing and discarded textile items.

The process involves separating the waste by color and cutting the materials into smaller pieces. These pieces are then blended and processed to achieve the desired content and color before being converted into fiber.




This fiber is spun into our recycled yarn, with no dyeing involved and all accomplished without water consumption.

Ultimately, the yarn is knitted into the various fabrics and weights found in our apparel collection.

Fairweather Johnson represents a sustainable closed-loop product solution.

Unisex Midweight Short Sleeve Ringer

During the 1960s, the ringer t-shirt emerged as a fashion essential for the youth and rock-n-roll enthusiasts. This decade also introduced tie-dyeing and screen-printing techniques, transforming the basic T-shirt into a canvas for wearable art. Warren Dayton, a designer known for his psychedelic art posters, was a pioneer in this movement, creating bold and colorful designs that featured political themes, protests, and pop culture icons. His T-shirts showcased images of figures like Cesar Chavez, along with political cartoons and other cultural references, as highlighted in a late 1969 article in the LA Times Magazine. Ironically, the clothing company soon discontinued this experimental line, fearing a lack of market interest.
